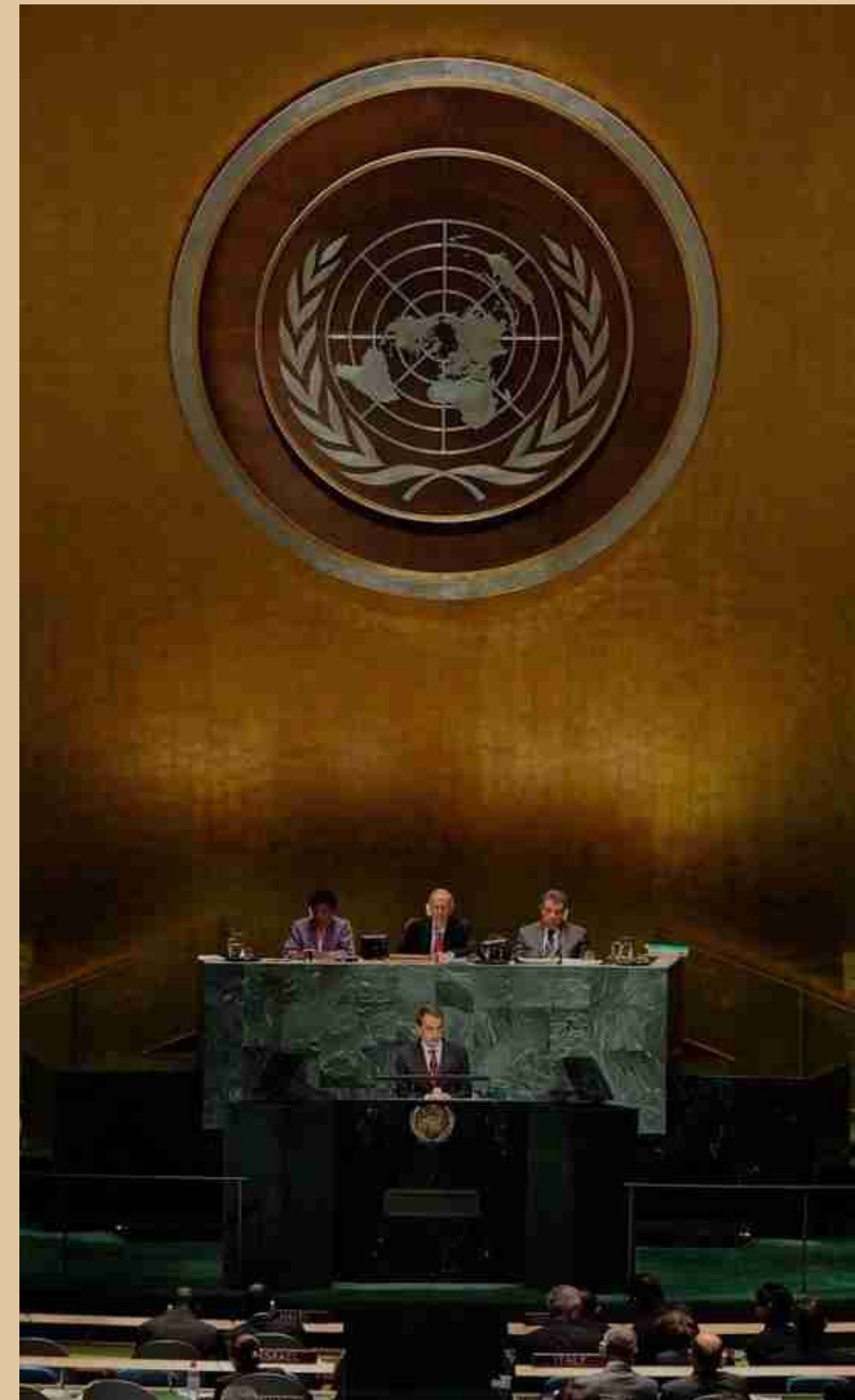

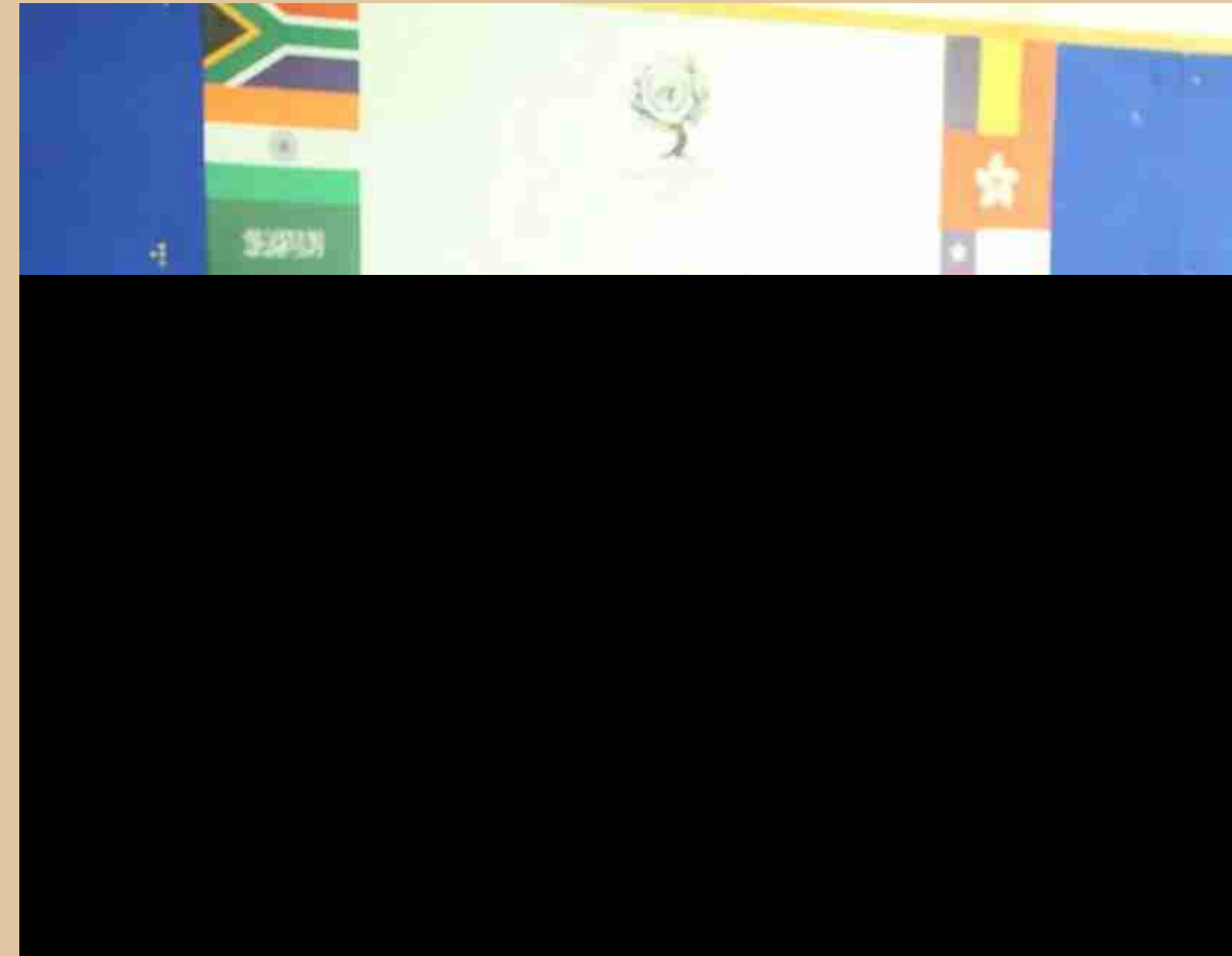


1.What is MUN?

3. Who are delegates ?

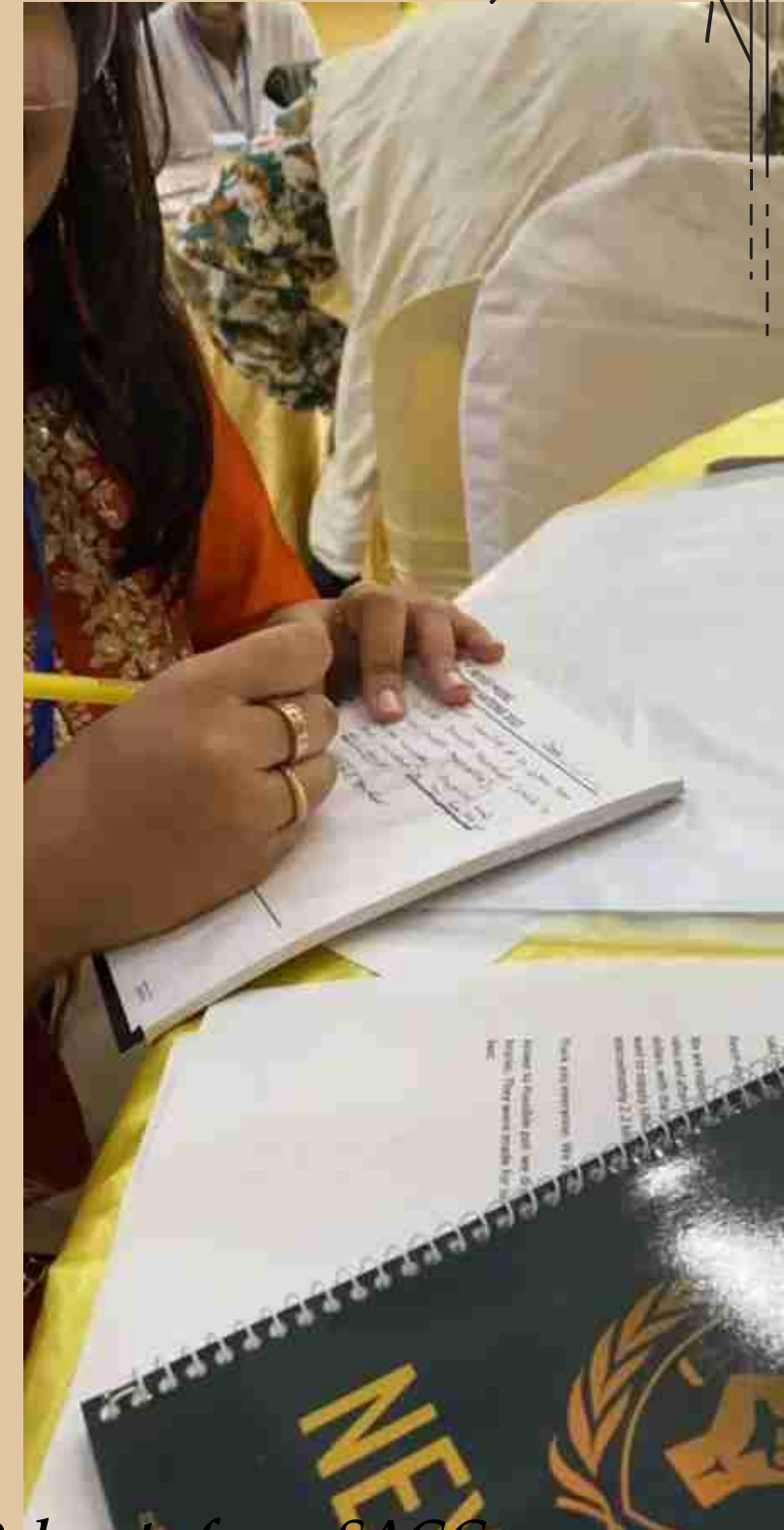
You along with other participants who are engaged in playing the role of global leaders and delegating a specific country are delegates.

4. What are the benefits of MUN?

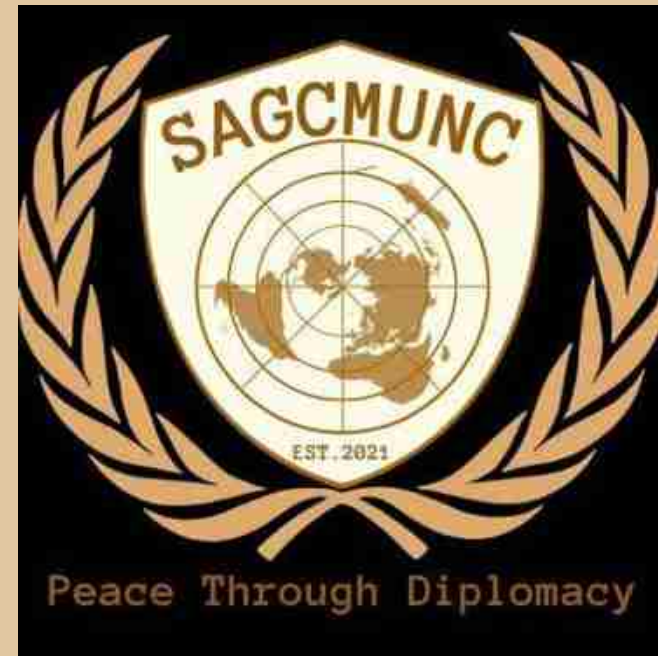
- i. Will improve behavioral skills.**

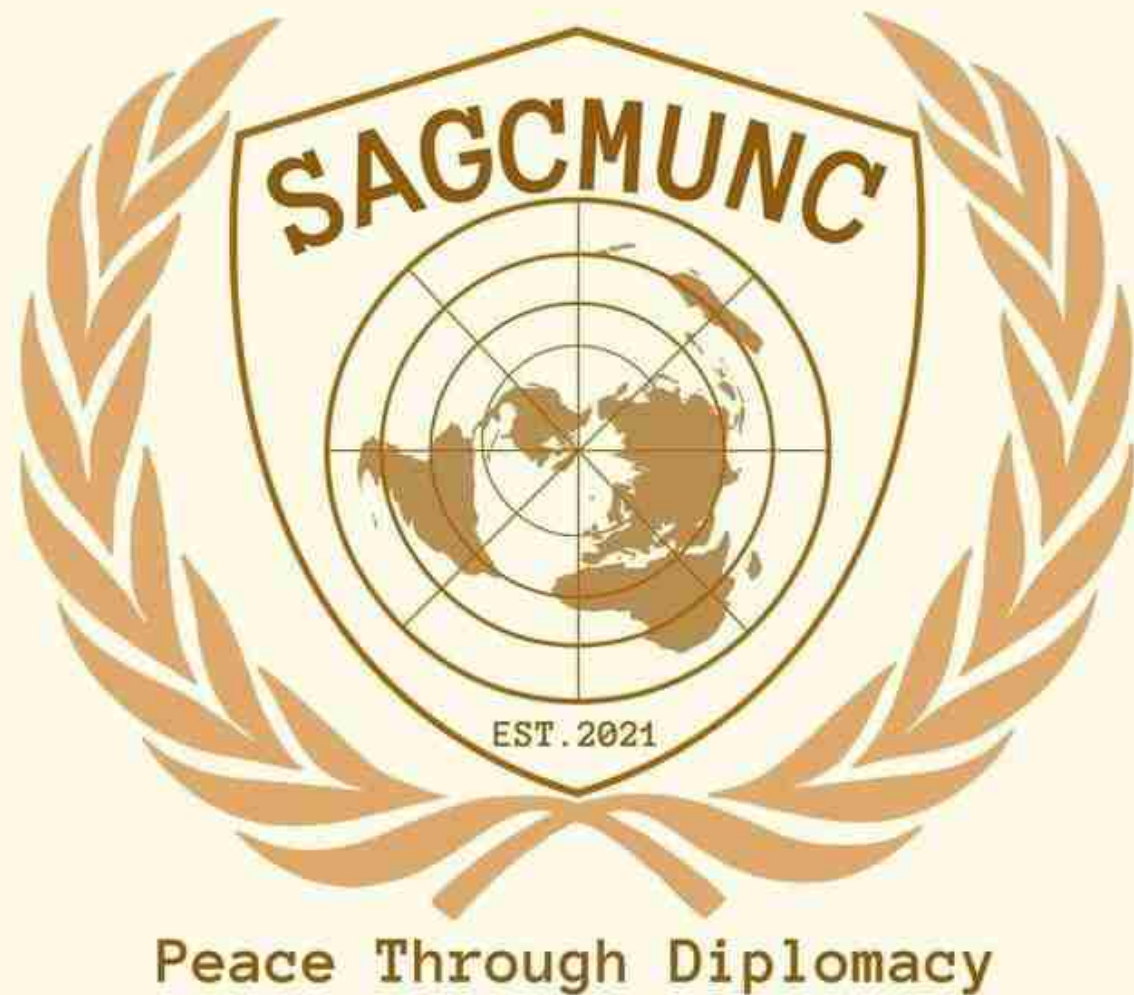


Emergence of SAGC- MUNC
