

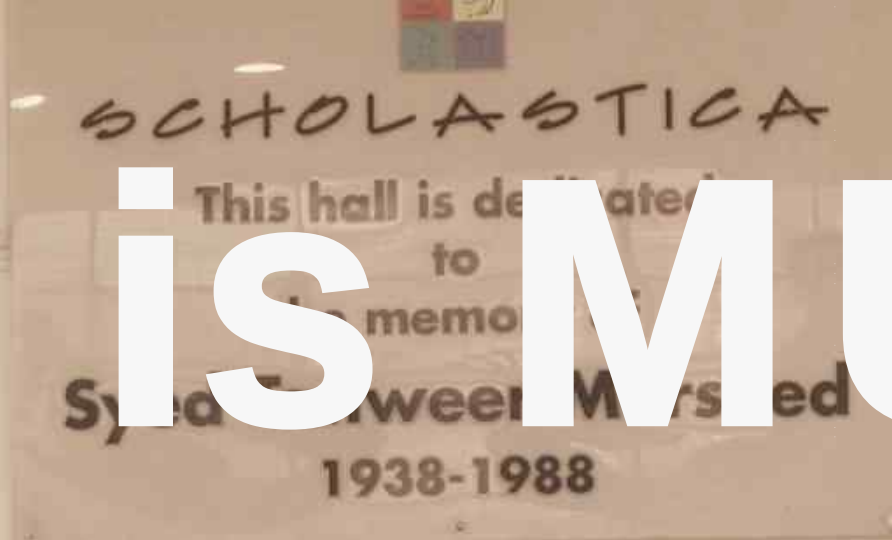

What is MUN?



Model United Nations (MUN)

is an educational activity where students simulate the meeting of the United Nations. Participants represent different countries and discuss global issues such as peace, security, human rights, climate change, and economic development. Through debate, negotiation, and resolution writing, students develop skills in public speaking, diplomacy, critical thinking, leadership, and teamwork. MUN helps young people gain a deeper understanding of international relations and world affairs while building confidence and communication abilities.





Who are the participants?



Participants in MUN (Model United Nations):

A delegate in MUN is a participant who represents an assigned country or organization in a committee, researches its policies, engages in debate and negotiation, drafts resolutions, and works with other delegates to address global issues.

Delegates serve in committees such as the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC), United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), and United Nations General Assembly (UNGA), where they discuss international challenges and propose solutions from the perspective of the country they represent.

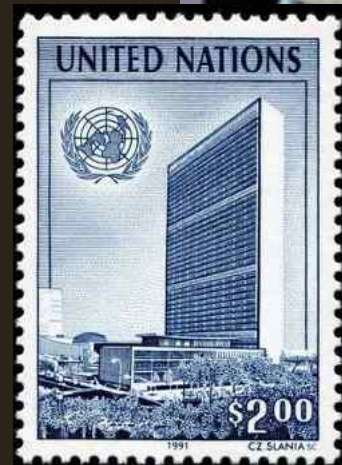

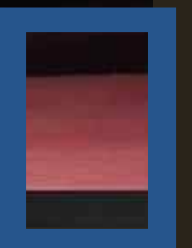
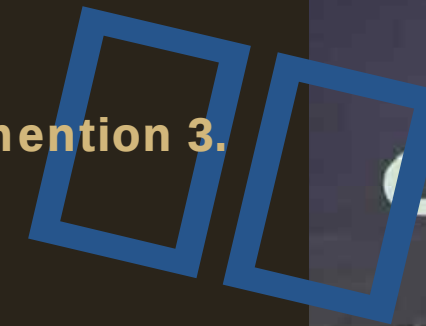
