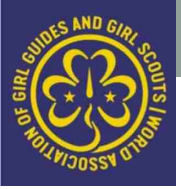

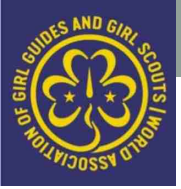

HISTORY

Robert Stephen Smith Baden Powel, the founder of world association of girl guides and girl scouts realized that in order to make girls more capable and prone to success in every sphere of the society, a separate organization for girls is very much essential alongside a boy's scout team. Following this realization, he established an independent platform for young as well as teenage girls which over the years came to be known as 'girls guide'. His wife Lady Olive Saint Care Some took a stronghold to this organization. The organization eventually spread its roots to 146 countries worldwide and came to be known as 'girls guide association.'

As a continuation to this, a team termed as 'senior girls guide team' was formed in 1916 which involved teenage and older girls. Later in the year 1920, this name was changed to 'Ranger'. In 1920, first international conference on guide was conducted in Oxford. Participants from different parts of the world joined this conference and turned the world guiding dream into a reality.



HISTORY

Bangladesh, a country that achieved freedom through struggle initiated the scouting and girls guide activities in 1972. Reforming the society, serving the poor and needy, improvement of ethical values, proper physical and mental development and religious tolerance etc. are the qualities that are incorporated through scouting and girls guide i.e. Ranger team. Bangladesh is earning much honor and respect by being a proud part of this initiative. This organization is active in this region since 1928. Bangladesh got recognition as a separate member of WAGS and has been training girls to develop leadership qualities. This topic has also been incorporated into our educational curriculum. It is also a part of training for teachers in primary school. More than 80 girls are trained every year in this regard. It has been emphasized in the textbook of higher secondary level. Keeping in mind of its great importance, like any other educational institutions the Ranger unit of SAGC college section was established as a part of Bangladesh girls guide association.

MEANING OF RANGER

- *Scout and girls guide i.e Ranger is an unpolitical social welfare based youth movement consisting of students from colleges and universities aged 16-26.*
- *Post joining ranger unit, students are obliged to clear an investiture test and qualify related examination in order to earn the Ranger badge. Thus, evolving for the betterment, students are taught to serve the society and the poor and needy.*
- *Girls guide ranger unit follows the same principle worldwide. Girl guides within the country are promoted step by step through successful completion of different activities based on their age. These activities are undertaken based on 8 point task. The girls are felicitated with a perfection badge based on the merit of their activities. Their hidden talent flourishes and skill improvement is encouraged through the giveaway of this badge. The organization guides them to develop leadership qualities through step by step level based ranger activities and to practice their democratic rights. Camping, rally, hiking, seminar, social service, workshop, voluntary involvement in different social programs and gatherings etc. helps our ranger girls to develop various good qualities and also develops their character and personality.*

SAGC RANGER UNIT FORMATION

- *Mubashwira Uddin Eshika and Sk Tazrian Islam, students of class 11 undertook the initiative in the view of formation of SAGC college section Ranger unit. Physical education teacher Mrs. Baby Rani Paul is currently working as the guide of this unit. - *Meanwhile, various activities were also undertaken within SAGC college section with the help and support of Bangladesh girls guide.*
